We have to turn away 80+ pets each week due to space and staff limitations.

The Opportunity: Save 600+ More Pets

Capital Campaign

With our capital campaign, we aim to raise \$600,000 to go toward: purchasing the property, making property improvements, growing our team, and paying for a marketing campaign to increase our visibility in the community.

Capital secured: \$85,000

- \$25,000 grant from Hirko Family Fund
- \$60,000 private donations toward the capital campaign

Capital Campaign Budget: \$600,000

- \$455,000: Downpayment (25%) for property purchase.
- \$50,000: Sound barrier wall behind rescue back yards.
- \$5,000: Back yard kennel installation.
- \$50,000: Property improvements to fit space to rescue needs.
- \$30,000: Additional staff
- \$10,000: Marketing budget for billboards, ads, and planning.
